

Governor Ligoya attends CCBG Meeting in Harare.

The Governor of the Reserve Bank of Malawi on Friday 1st October 2010 attended the Meeting of the SADC Committee of Central Bank Governors (CCBG) at the Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe conference centre in Harare. Governor of Reserve Bank of Zimbabwe Dr. Gideon Gono hosted the meeting which was chaired by the Chairperson of the CCBG and Governor of Reserve Bank of South Africa Ms. Gill Marcus. This was the last CCBG meeting of 2010 and the main aim was for Governors to note and approve activities conducted by the sub-committees in the implementation of regional integration drive.

This was also the last CCBG meeting that Governor Ligoya attended as Chairperson of the Southern Africa sub-region of the Association of African Central Banks (AACB). He informed the meeting that he was endorsed by the Assembly of Governors of the AACB as the Vice Chairman of the AACB in Dakar, Senegal and therefore ceases to be the regional Chair. CCBG Governors approved his proposal that appointment and succession to the Chairmanship of the sub-region in Southern Africa should follow alphabetical order. To this effect, Banco Nationale du Angola was elected as the new Chair of the Southern Africa sub-region of the AACB.

The Governor also informed the meeting that Malawi shall host the 35th Assembly of Governors of the AACB in August 2011.
